## **DEVELOPMENTAL MILESTONES: FINE MOTOR SKILLS**

Age	Developmental Milestones	Possible implications if milestones not achieved
0 - 6 months	<ul> <li>Reflexive grasp (at birth)</li> <li>Global ineffective reach for objects (3 months)</li> <li>Voluntary grasp (3 months)</li> <li>2 handed palmar grasp (3 months)</li> <li>1 handed palmar grasp (5 months)</li> <li>Controlled reach (6 months)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Poor muscle development</li> <li>Delayed ability to play independently</li> <li>Delayed sensory development due to delayed interaction with toys and other sensory objects</li> </ul>
6 - 12 months	<ul> <li>Reaches, grasps, puts object in mouth</li> <li>Controlled release of objects</li> <li>Pincer grasp</li> <li>Picks things up with pincer grasp (thumb and one finger)</li> <li>Transfers object from one hand to the other</li> <li>Drops and picks up toy</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Poor development of hand and finger strength</li> <li>Poor manipulation of objects resulting in delayed play skills</li> <li>Delayed sensory development due to lack of sensory play experiences</li> </ul>
1 -2 years	<ul> <li>Builds tower of three small blocks</li> <li>Puts four rings on stick</li> <li>Places five pegs in pegboard</li> <li>Turns pages two or three at a time</li> <li>Scribbles</li> <li>Turns knobs</li> <li>Paints with whole arm movement, shifts hands, makes strokes</li> <li>Self-feeds with minimal assistance</li> <li>Able to use signing to communicate</li> <li>Brings spoon to mouth</li> <li>Holds and drinks from cup independently</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Poor development of hand and finger strength</li> <li>Delayed independent play skills</li> <li>Delayed development of self care skills such as eating</li> <li>Delayed manipulation skills</li> </ul>
2-3 years	<ul> <li>Strings four large beads</li> <li>Turns single pages</li> <li>Snips with scissors</li> <li>Holds crayon with thumb and fingers (not fist)</li> <li>Uses one hand consistently in most activities</li> <li>Imitates circular, vertical, horizontal strokes</li> <li>Paints with some wrist action, makes dots, lines, circular strokes</li> <li>Rolls, pounds, squeezes, and pulls play-dough</li> <li>Eats without assistance</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Delayed self-care skills such as eating</li> <li>Delayed pre-writing skills development</li> <li>Delayed manipulation of small objects such as toys, pencils and scissors</li> <li>Frustration when manipulating small toys and objects</li> </ul>

## **DEVELOPMENTAL MILESTONES: FINE MOTOR SKILLS CONTINUED**

Age	Developmental Milestones	Possible implications if milestones not achieved
3 - 4 years	<ul> <li>Builds tower of nine small blocks</li> <li>Manipulates clay material (rolls balls, makes snakes, cookies)</li> <li>Uses non dominant hand to assist and stabilise the use of objects</li> <li>Snips paper using scissors</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Delayed pre-writing skills development</li> <li>Frustration and/or avoidance of pencil based tasks</li> <li>Poor pencil grasp and pencil control</li> <li>Poor self-care skills such as eating</li> <li>Delayed drawing skills</li> </ul>
4 -5 years	<ul> <li>Cuts on line continuously</li> <li>Copies cross</li> <li>Copies square</li> <li>Writes name</li> <li>Writes numbers 1-5</li> <li>Copies letters</li> <li>Left or right handed determined</li> <li>Dresses and undresses independently</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Difficulties holding and manipulating a pencil</li> <li>Difficulties learning to write name and other letters of the alphabet</li> <li>Dependence on caregivers for every day activities such as dressing</li> <li>Frustration and/or avoidance of pencil based tasks</li> </ul>
5 - 6 years	<ul> <li>Cuts out simple shapes</li> <li>Copies triangle</li> <li>Colours within lines</li> <li>Uses a 3 fingered grasp of pencil and uses fingers to generate movement</li> <li>Pastes and glues appropriately</li> <li>Can draw basic pictures</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Difficulties learning to form letters correctly</li> <li>Poor handwriting</li> <li>Fatigue during pencil based tasks</li> <li>Frustration and/or avoidance of pencil based tasks</li> </ul>
6 -7 years	<ul> <li>Forms most letters and numbers correctly</li> <li>Writes consistently on the lines</li> <li>Demonstrates controlled pencil movement</li> <li>Good endurance for writing</li> <li>Can build Lego / blocks independently</li> <li>Ties shoelaces</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Difficulties getting ideas down on paper</li> <li>Experiencing fatigue during handwriting tasks</li> <li>Difficulty keeping up in class due to slow handwriting speed</li> <li>Poor legibility of handwriting</li> <li>May impact on self-esteem when comparing work to peers</li> <li>Possible frustration and/or behaviour difficulties due to avoidance of pencil based tasks</li> </ul>
7- 8 years	Maintains legibility of handwriting for entirety of a story	<ul> <li>Difficulty completing handwriting tasks in a timely manner</li> <li>Experiencing fatigue during handwriting tasks</li> <li>Poor academic achievement due to difficulty getting ideas down on paper</li> <li>Difficulties due to avoidance of pencil based tasks</li> </ul>
